

General Information

Thank you so much for your interest in Studienkolleg Düsseldorf. The Studienkolleg Düsseldorf is one of the best Studienkollegs in Germany. Every year, we have more than 300 students from around the world visiting our Studienkolleg and we have each semester lots of successful graduates.

I. Preparatory courses

The Studienkolleg Düsseldorf starts on **01. September** for the **winter semester** and on **01. February** for the **summer semester**. We do <u>not</u> conduct an entrance examination. Please check your certificates to ensure that you meet the entry requirements for the Feststellungsprüfung (uni-assist.de, Anabin.org).

The duration of our preparatory courses / foundation year courses (T-course, W-course, M-course) is 38 weeks and includes 36 lessons per week. The duration of our M+T-course is also 38 weeks and includes 42 teaching units. The preparatory courses prepare you optimally for the examination, so that the absolvents can apply for the desired subject at each German university.

The one-year (2 semesters) tuition fees for the T-course, W-course, and M-course is:

- **6.490** € (5.995 € Course fee + 495 € Application fee).

The one-year (2 semesters) tuition fees for the M+T-course is:

- 8.020 € (7.525 € Course fee + 495 € Application fee).
 - The Preparatory Course Descriptions

The <u>T-course</u> aims at applicants who have to pass the T-assessment test / Feststellungsprüfung in order to be eligible for mathematical, scientific, technical or engineering science bachelor degree programs.

Written examination subjects: German, Mathematics, Physics

Oral examination subjects: Chemistry

The <u>M-course</u> aims at applicants who have to pass the M-assessment test / Feststellungsprüfung in order to be eligible for medical, biological or pharmaceutical bachelor degree programs.

Written examination subjects: German, Biology, Physics

Oral examination subjects: Chemistry

The <u>W-course</u> aims at applicants who have to pass the assessment test / Feststellungsprüfung in order to be eligible for economical and socio-scientific bachelor degree programs.

Written examination subjects: German, Mathematics, Economics

Oral examination subjects: English



The combined <u>M+T-course</u> aims at applicants who haven't decided whether they need to pass the T- or M-assessment test / Feststellungsprüfung in order to be eligible for medical, biological and pharmaceutical, or mathematical scientific technical and engineering science bachelor degree programs.

They can decide which direction is more appealing to them during their studies and take the corresponding assessment test / Feststellungsprüfung. There is an opportunity to re-take the missing exam subject after 6 months.

Pre-Course German B1/B2

The entry requirement of German language for our preparatory courses is **B1/B2 German language**. For applicants who do not yet have **B1/B2 knowledge of German**, we offer the **Pre-German B1 course** and the **Pre-German B2 course**.

Our Pre-Course German takes your language proficiency level to B2 in accordance with the Common



European Framework of Reference (CEFR). Here you will be trained intensively in the four skills, listening, reading, writing and speaking, so that you are well prepared for the Studienkolleg and studies in Germany.

Feststellungsprüfung (FSP)

The preparatory courses prepare you for a demanding <u>Feststellungsprüfung</u>. This examination is organized by the government and therefore recognized by all German universities. It consists of a written and an oral part.

The Feststellungsprüfung determines whether the technical and linguistic requirements for studying at a German university are met. Once you have passed this Feststellungsprüfung, you can apply for a degree in the relevant subjects in any German university.

II. German Language Courses & telc Examination Centre

German Language Courses

Learning the German language allows you to integrate better and faster into the life in Germany, and prepares you for the future study and work in Germany. Our <u>Intensive-German-Course</u> will bring you new successes!

At Studienkolleg Düsseldorf, you can take a course for any of the levels (A1 to C1) every month! The courses are divided into 10 levels: A1.1, A1.2, A2.1, A2.2, B1.1, B1.2, B2.1, B2.2, C1.1, and C1.2. This allows you to begin a course every month with the level you need. One course lasts four weeks. The **course fees** are **495€** plus a <u>one-off registration fee</u> of **45€**. If there is sufficient demand, we can also offer <u>German evening courses</u> and <u>private lessons</u>.

telc Exam Center

Studienkolleg Düsseldorf is an official <u>telc examination center</u>, offering telc tests Deutsch B1, B2, C1 Hochschule and even more examinations. In order to properly prepare the students for these exams, we are also offering our <u>telc preparatory courses</u>.

- School leaving certificate (original & in German translated) *
- School transcript of records (original & in German translated) *
